



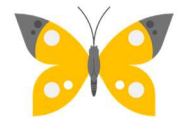

## Information Tidbits

In the last newsletter I discussed the founding of Baruch and some of the principles upon which the ministry is based. As I reflect on that time, and the years following, honoring God and serving people as they age have been the foundation of Baruch Senior Ministries. Twenty-five years ago this fall, blocks were laid. From its inception the ministry has grown from one home in Coopersville to 27 homes throughout Michigan, from one part time leased employee to over 900 employees, to serving thousands of residents and family members. One feature of our anniversary celebration later this year will be a timeline of significant events during the past 25 years: the purchase of homes, construction of others, and expansion of services. We will remember other impactful events: the start of our Spiritual Care program, increasing numbers of chaplains, development of our own human resources, advancement and finance teams, the Michigan Supreme Court's ruling in our favor regarding property tax relief, and many others that have benefitted our ministry. Through many changes built on the same foundation God has blessed this ministry. Silver anniversary events will be detailed in the next months!

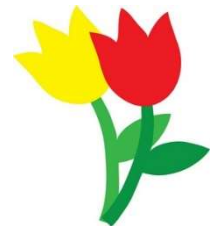


### A Springtime Prayer
